## **Privacy policy**

- Right of access: The interested party shall have the right to request and obtain, free of charge, information on their personal data subject to processing, the origin of such data, and the communications made or planned to be made of the same. The information may be obtained by

simply consulting the data by means of their visualisation, or by indicating the data being processed by means of writing, copy, fax or photocopy, certified or not, in legible and intelligible form, without the use of codes or codes requiring the use of specific mechanical devices.

This right may only be exercised at intervals of no less than twelve months, unless the data subject accredits a legitimate interest to that effect, in which case it may be exercised earlier.

- Right of rectification and cancellation: Personal data whose processing does not comply with the provisions of Organic Law 15/1999 and, in particular, when such data is inaccurate or incomplete, may be rectified or cancelled, as the case may be.

The {razon\_social} shall enforce the right of rectification or cancellation of the interested party within ten days.

The cancellation will lead to the blocking of the data, being kept only at the disposal of the Public Administrations, Judges and Courts, for the attention of possible liabilities arising from the processing, during the period of prescription of these.

Once the aforementioned period has expired, the data will be deleted. In the event that the rectified or cancelled data had been previously communicated, {razon\_social} will notify the rectification or cancellation carried out to the person to whom it was communicated, in the event that the processing is maintained by the latter, who must also proceed with the cancellation.

For the procedures in which the rights of opposition, access, rectification or cancellation are exercised, the provisions of the regulations shall apply, without any consideration being required.

The data to be completed in this procedure are those that have been considered pertinent, adequate and not excessive in relation to the purpose for which they were obtained.
